

Horse Trap On Stud Creek

This horse trap can be found on the East side of the drift fence located at Stud Creek.

To find it, a person can ride the old Telephone Line Trail from the ranch building site to West Lakes. Watch for the old insulators hanging from trees. Unfortunately over the past 8 years, some people have removed these so there are not as many left. This trail will lead you to the old horse trap if you know where to go.

The trap is located on the east side of Stud Creek about a mile or so up from the Cascade Fire Road. The trap was built in 1917 by Jack Fuller, Boney Thompson and others who were attempting to round up the Brewster horses after the Brewster's lease had expired.
