BIGHORN CAMPGROUND COVID REGULATIONS

PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY TO MAKE SURE YOU HAVE ALL THE INFORMATION BEFORE HEADING CAMPING

BIGHORN CAMPGROUND TO OPEN JUNE 26, 2020

Parks Canada has announced the opening of Federal campgrounds including Bighorn Campground on the June 22, 2020. However, due to restrictions imposed on Friends of the Eastern Slopes, we will not be opening the Bighorn Campground until June 26, 2020 in order to allow us to meet the restrictions imposed.

Restrictions include the following:

1. Operate at no more than 75% occupancy with physical distancing between campsites. The following is the recommendation from the Federal Government:

"This could be achieved by not allowing any free standing panels. There are 30 campsites with either Stalls or Highline Poles. This should be the maximum equestrian campsites to be used, with non-equestrian campers ensuring they are 100 feet apart from the next campsite and using existing fire circles. No New fire circles are to be built."

With this restriction, NO PANELS WILL BE ALLOWED

More than one unit will be allowed at each campsite

2. Increased cleaning of washrooms.

Washrooms will be cleaned daily on the weekends however

- practice good hygiene:
- wash your hands frequently
- -refrain from touching your face with unclean hands
- -carry and use hand sanitizer
- Be self-sufficient. Take in what you need
- 3. A sandwich board sign for the bathrooms to read "Closed for Cleaning" to help ensure personal distancing between campers and cleaners.

If you see the "Closed for Cleaning" signs at the bathroom, please go to a different bathroom and keep your distance

4. A Campground Host is to be on site to direct visitors, give information and relay to ranch staff any infractions.

We will have a Campground Host available at our usual spot at the Bighorn Campground to assist with the above requirement

5. A large sandwich board indicating "CAMPGROUND FULL" to be available to the Bighorn Campground Host to post when 75% capacity is reached.

We will be providing the Campground Host with 2 signs so the second one can be placed by the entry gate to the ranch so late arrivals on Friday can turn around and head directly to Eagle Creek, rather than driving all the way in to the Bighorn.

Hand sanitizers have been put into the bathrooms at Bighorn Campground and are to be put in at Eagle Creek once they have been provided to us.

Alberta non-residents are expected to follow the travel restrictions set out by the Province during this time.

PLEASE ABIDE BY THE RESTRICTIONS SET OUT ABOVE IN ORDER THAT WE MAY KEEP THE CAMPGROUND OPEN AND HOPEFULLY SOON WE WILL BE AT FULL CAPACITY AGAIN.
